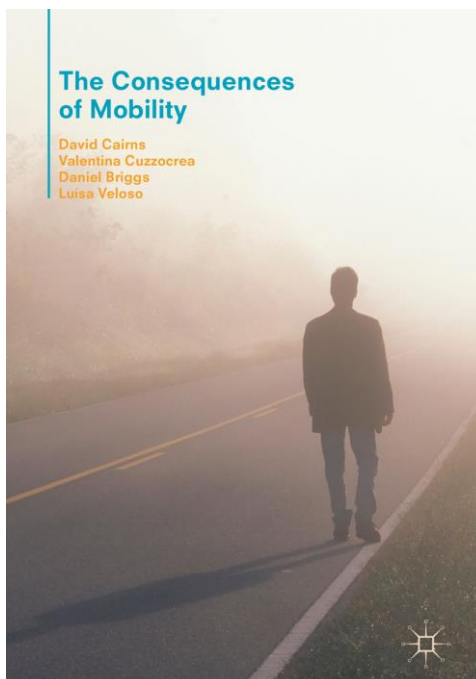

Thinking about new generations' futures today implies on-going acts of re-imagination, a focus on a more open and multifaceted perception of the field in terms of multiple possibilities, a view of possible and probable futures as emerging from imaginative and hopeful and not only wilful anticipations.

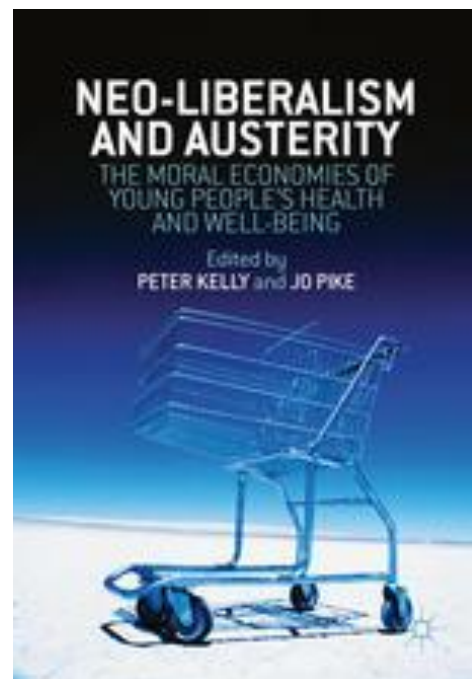
